

As we have shared, our church has welcomed several refugee families coming from Latin and South America. There are many more latinos and latinas living in our area. We have tried, with some success, to reach out to them but have realized for a long time that much more could and should be done. Time keep us from being able to do more. It seems that the Lord has answered our prayers to 'Send more workers to the harvest." Just over a week ago I was at the airport to pick-up the Alcivar family.

Uri and Carmen and their children Emmanuel and Abigail are originally from Mexico. They are presently living near Grand Rapids where Uri is finishing a theological degree. The Lord has led them to apply to serve with United World Mission and they are to be fielded to Belgium as soon as their visa is issued by the Belgian authorities (prayer subject!). Their desire is to come and work alongside us to provide edification and mentoring to the existing latino community and to reach out to the many refugees in our city and beyond. They also have a passion and some training in strengthening marriages and families.

On Sunday they were welcomed by the latino community of our church. Fellowship for many latinos is spelled "F O O D" so they had cooked a Belgian specialty for them.

On Monday we introduced Emmanuel and Abigail to the schools that they will be attending. They seem ready to tackle the challenge of learning yet another language. Another prayer subject! On Wednesday Uri led the Bible Study in Spanish which greatly encouraged the Spanish speaking believers and was appreciated by all present.

They are presently attending UWM's EuroConference before flying back to the US on Monday May 6th. They'll come back as soon as the visas are granted!!

Myriam and I as well as Timothy, Divine and family are also in Albania for the EuroConference. Flying with three kids under four was a challenge. They did so well!—just natural missionary kids Daniel is leading this event which has been in preparation for many months. Yours prayers are appreciated. We'll share more about it when back in Belgium.
