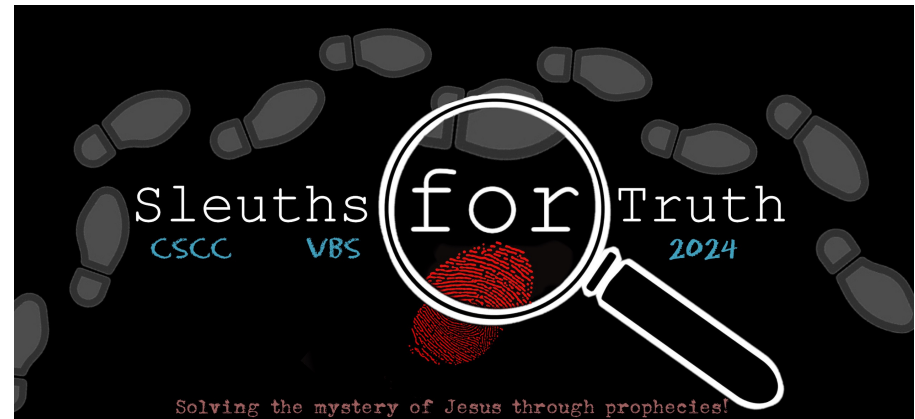

In our last prayer update, we asked prayer for the damage done to some of our facilities during the wind storm. We had wonderful opportunities to minister in Khayamandi, Stellenbosch this past month. Food parcels, household goods, clothing and tracts were distributed to the families who lost their shacks in the fire. It has taken us all month to rebuild the outside walls at the new residential home from the damage by the wind storm. We believe we are now ready to move forward with the submission of the building plans.

Simanyene Bible Church of Strand

For the next few months, we would like to highlight our family of churches and ministries. In the picture on the right is Odwa, Tisetso and Nkosana. They are the 3 pastors of the churches. They grew up together, trusted in Christ in their late teens and graduated from CMI to go on and pastor these churches. Each one of them works full time and has a team that the Lord has raised up to help lead in each church.

Simanyene Bible Church is now 16 years old and Odwa (on the left) is the pastor of that church. It has had many struggles over the years but has a strong core group and have recently begun to grow again. They are a true light in the midst of a very dark township.

Simanyene Center for the Disabled uses their building during the week. This church also has a special ministry to the children and young adults at the residential home, bringing them to church each Sunday. Much of their ministry focus is on the youth in their community and special needs.

1. Pray for faithfulness and unity in their young ladies Bible class.
2. Church attendance for their youth at Simanyene. They come to Bible study and youth group, but have not yet transitioned into church on Sunday morning.
