

Please pray for his pain to decrease, for his hunger and thirst to not overwhelm him (he can think of nothing else right now), for safety on the 5 1/2 hour drive tomorrow, for wisdom in knowing what to do next, for no surgery, and for those of us left at home waiting. Matt will administer the IV fluids and meds here at home tonight and in Kampala tomorrow.

No matter what, we know God is in control and that He loves Nathaniel even more than I do. God is good.
