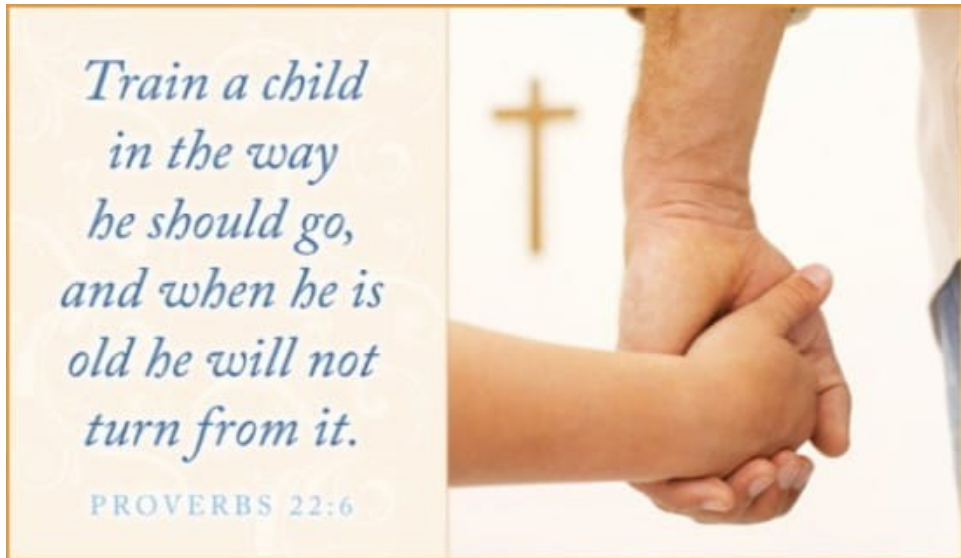

Dear Praying Friends

This month we are reminded of Proverbs 16:9 which says, "A man's heart plans his way, but the LORD directs his steps." We had planned to start the building project in Stellenbosch, but the Lord has brought us a special blessing.

We have a wedding coming up ☺. This is a very big deal for our churches. In the 19 years we have been here, there have only been 3 weddings. Thulani and Yolanda from the Mfuleni Church are getting married on the 10th of November. Why is this such a big event? In the Xhosa culture, there are so many obstacles for our young people to overcome, that marriage is a rare thing. It is easier for them to just live together and never bother to get married due to these obstacles: 1) There is the lobola (payment) that they must come up with to marry the girl. The prettier and more educated the girl – the higher the lobola. 2) They must pay for their own wedding after lobola. 3) The families do very little to encourage marriage or help with the costs. Typically, the Xhosa young man must be in his late 20's and well established to marry.

It is our hope that we might encourage marriages using Thulani & Yolanda's as an example for our young people. It is a very simple wedding. We are using our new residential home back garden as our venue; the church is paying for the food; I am making the wedding cake (my first time ever and I have been practicing) and Wayne is working hard on the back garden and will braai the meat (BBQ). We have done all we can to help make it affordable and not burden them with debt. We'll send a few pictures next month. Please pray for this important day.

Prayer Requests:

- The Stellenbosch building project is on hold until after the wedding.
- The upcoming wedding of Thulani & Yolanda on November 10th.
- The building plans for our new home are waiting on HOA (Homeowner's Association) approval and we won't hear anything until after their Annual Meeting in December. General
