I'M HEADED BACK TO PAPUA NEW GUINEA!

So much has happened in the last eight months, and it is all culminating in my return to Papua New Guinea (PNG) for the long haul! I depart the USA from Los Angeles this Sunday, October 27th. As God grants me health and strength, I will continue to work with the Nali translation team until we see at least their whole New Testament published, and, hopefully, many more media resources produced.

MY DAD MOVED TO HEAVEN IN MARCH.

On March 3rd, my father, Richard Amber, Preached his sermon in the little country church that he loved so much in Jobstown, New Jersey. That night he collapsed, was hospitalized, and never made it home again. Although radiation treatments in the Fall of 2023 had cured his tongue cancer, he never regained his sense of taste, weight, strength or stamina. On March 21st he joined Jesus while peacefully sleeping in the rehab center where he was hopping to recover his walking strength. He was 98 years old.

LIFE WAS VERY FULL THESE LAST SEVEN MONTHS

With my dad's passing, my sisters and I went into clean-out-mode. Cleaning out the 115 year-old house my dad had owned for 68 years, and putting it up for sale. For me, it was an education in the knob-and-tube electrical wiring of the early 1900's and in basement asbestos. By God's grace, the house is now sold.

In July, my son-in-law, Ben Quine, drove all my possessions that had been stored in New Jersey to his homestead in Texas. It looks like my retirement will someday be as a Texan!

Two of my friends, Linda Krol and Carol Rech, came from Chicago in August to help me drive my PNG cargo from New Jersey to North Carolina. We stopped in Virginia to visit with our mutual friend, Sarah Broomell then headed to the JARRS center where we packed my items to ship overseas.

The final even of my time in MT. Holly was celebrating a high school reunion with 105 of my classmates. I can't think of a more joyous affair to have closed out this chapter of my life.

I HAVE A NEW GRANDSON!

On September 20th, Everett Ray Popahas Pfaff was born to Callie and Mathew in Cypress, California. Everett ("strong and brave") Ray ("wise counselor") Popahas (Nali for "grace") was named after a much-loved grandfather. His birth merited a trip for some precious cuddle time with this dear new grandson, and some play time with big sister Emie Jo before I leave the country. A bonus to the visit was learning that Keely and Nathan, who live in Los Angeles and are expecting their first child in

April, will be having a girl! The count is now four grandsons and two granddaughters to call me "Grandmom."

I WILL HIT THE GROUND RUNNING IN PNG

After five days of my settling in at the Ukarumpa Centre, a team of five Nali speakers will arrive from Manus Island so we can meet with a translation consultant to check the Nali translation of the books of Hebrews and James. Each book that gets consultant checked gets us closer to completing the Nali New Testament. I look forward to being in the same time zone as my team and to being able to focus more on the work ahead of us. Thank you so much for praying for wisdom, mental alertness, and stamina as we press on!

Your encouragement, love, and support have carried me through the three most difficult years of my life. Thank you from the bottom of my heart!
