Hi friends, thank you for your continued prayers for us. We love when we hear from you and are encouraged by your faithfulness to our Father, and also to us!

The last term was quite an ending to the year with many twists and turns in the unknown. We are thankful for the confident trust we can have in our Father, and even more thankful for His kindness to us in the midst of uncertainty.

We jumped in where Nomonde had left off, and seeing the need for the teens, created a teen ministry. We continued with Kid's Club on Wednesday afternoons, ages 6-12, and created Teens at Thola on Fridays, ages 13-19. Two weeks into the term a twist came and Mthoko handed his teaching ministry off to Bongeka. For the purpose of focusing on Studies and Character Development. This will allow him more time with multiple ministry mentors, time for his studies, and time for us to grow as a couple to prepare and set us up well for our future life and ministry. We praise the Lord for counselors who love the Lord and who love us and want to see us glorify God together to the best of our ability!

Asking Bongeka to teach on Wednesday and Fridays was something none of us saw coming, but WOW did she jump in head first! She loves the kids, interacts well, and has built a relationship with them. On Wednesday anywhere from 20-50 come, and Fridays from 10-35 depending on the local soccer schedule.

Prayers are appreciated as we continue this ministry, there are challenges that would be best solved if they accepted Christ, then the Holy Spirit would change behaviors and attitudes from the inside out. But until Jesus saves them, we are called to love them well and discipline when it's hard. As in any ministry, there are days we leave encouraged or discouraged. It requires lots of prayer. In this last term the Lord has convicted me in regards to these challenges and how badly they need Christ. So, at each teen night I take the sign-in sheet home with me. Then in the next week Mthoko and I sit down and pray for every single teenager on the list. It's encouraging going to the Lord on their behalf, and to grow more love and compassion for them as we go.

The year ended with the usual three week schedule of year end functions. We were thankful to end with our annual Christmas Parties for the kids. The Lord provided food, presents, and plenty of teachers to share the Gospel with these little ones. We desire to always end well, though there is still more work to be done before Christ returns, but when He comes we are confident He will bring it to completion perfectly.
