Dear Pastor Lowther & Saints of Camp Springs Community Church

We are trying to be patient, but admittedly our patience is wearing a bit thin. We have had many days of disappointments and frustrations over the past six months, but your care, prayers and support for us have been uplifting to us: we praise the Lord for saints such as you who continue to show God's love to us during this challenging time in our lives. Thank you so much for your expressions of love via your prayers and/or financial support. We are officially still in a 'post furlough' time, trying to find some time to rest after a lifetime of foreign ministry.

We continue enjoying some time with family which includes Ron's brother, his sister, nieces and nephews living in our area. We so much missed their company over the past 30 years due to our time in Australia: our last Christmas together with family here was in the year 2000: this is because we took so few furloughs and usually, we had left the USA before Christmas because our Australian Religious Instruction ministry started every January. We continue attending a very good church here in Murfreesboro and are starting to get to know a few more people which is encouraging because we need to make new friends here. This city of Murfreesboro should be called 'the city of churches' because there are so many here. It is so refreshing to our souls to see biblical emphasis on the reason for this season, the birth of Jesus Christ. We thank you so much for all you have done for us, and we praise the Lord for your faithfulness. God bless you.
