Dear Praying Friends,

We always evaluate the ministries from the year before to see if they have been fruitful or if there are changes that need to be made. I looked at my list and realized I could not give up or add anything more than I do! Wayne will be teaching more in the Mfuleni Church to carry some of the weight of the ministry from Pastor Tisetso who was overloaded with Bible studies and discipleship last year.

We live in a small Afrikaans village where there is a vineyard behind us and a farm. Day after day, when I would take my walk, I would watch an 82-year-old man wheel his wheelchair up from the farm into the village to sit each day. His wheelchair was in very bad shape with literally no tread left on the wheels. I thought that we could certainly do better than that for a wheelchair for him, so I found a quality wheelchair and gave it to him. I learned that his name is George and he could understand and speak some English. Each day we greeted each other and sometimes I would push him to the corner. Wayne noticed Mr. George and gave him a cup of coffee and some bread one day. After this, Mr. George would stop by our curbside almost every day and Wayne began to talk with him and shared the gospel with him. The next week Mr. George came by our house and wanted to tell us that he had trusted in the Lord Jesus. Most mornings, if the weather is nice, Mr. George stops at the curb of our home and waits for Wayne to come out with a cup of coffee, a passage of scripture from John's gospel and prayer to start the day. He now comes with a smile and a sparkle in his eyes that we never really noticed before. What began by supplying a physical need. God used to meet this man's spiritual need.
